Chapter-I

Introduction:-

Section 23 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 provides that there shall be a Disaster Management Plan for every State. Section 40 of the said Act requires every Department of the State to prepare their Disaster Management Plan. The Departmental Disaster Management Plan shall be approved by State Executive Committee of Assam State Disaster Management Authority. Accordingly, this Disaster Management Plan prepared will be operative for Secondary and Elementary Education Department.

Major Disasters

Assam lies in Zone V, one of the most seismically active regions of the world. This is one reason why earthquakes of very high intensity are occurring regularly in this region. Two great earthquakes which occurred on 12 June 1897 with epicenter near Rongjuli, Assam (magnitude 8.7) and on 15 August 1950 with epicenter at Tajoobum, Arunachal Pradesh (magnitude 8.5) are regarded among most severe earthquakes in world history. Large scale devastation took place on both occasions. As many as 20 destructive earthquakes of magnitudes 6 to 7 have rocked this region during past century only recently during/after the devastation in Nepal mild tremors have rocked state of Assam. Scientific publications have warned that very severe earthquakes are likely to occur anytime in Assam, which could adversely affect lives of people and more importantly the student and teaching fraternity.

Assam also falls in the highest rainfall intensity zone of the country. The precipitation here is mainly due to the South-West monsoon i.e. June to September and the average annual rainfall in the region is very high and ranges from 1750 mm in the plains to about 6400 mm in the hills. Thus there is huge release of water and the volume of water rushes through the valley of Assam and Barak Basin to the Bay of Bangal ravaging the area through which it flows with floods and land erosion. The recurring floods on an average devastate about 20% of the total area of the plain districts of the State Assam and in the high flood years the devastation has been recorded to be as high as 67%.

Storms & Cyclones

Assam is also prone to serve seasonal storms and violent cyclones causing damage to property by destroying houses, damaging vital installations, uprooting big trees, disrupting communication and transport and cause loss of lives in large numbers.

Disaster Preparedness Plan:-

Disaster Preparedness Plan ensures that systems are in place to provide prompt assistance to disaster victims in the first 48 hours or so when outside help has not reached. This is accomplished through formulating or implementing:

- Community awareness/education.
- Disaster plans.
- Training/test exercises.
- Emergency communications.
- Evacuation plans.
- Warning systems.
- Resource inventories.

Profile & Objectives:-

The primary objective of Departmental disaster management plan is ensuring the safety security and well being of the student fraternity and the teaching staff of the schools and the connecting Institutions.

The secondary objective is safety and security of the properties of the educational institutions under the jurisdiction of Secondary and Elementary Education Department and the life's of the teachers, employees and staff of the institutions.

Apart from this the other main objectives are (1) Ensure all components of Disaster Management are addressed to facilitate Planning, Preparedness, Operational, Co-ordination and Community participation (2) Inclusion of Disaster Management in the routine affairs of the Department (3) Prompt and effective discharge of departmental responsibilities during disaster situation (4) Ensuring safety of departmental infrastructures, human resource and other assets (5) Speedy restoration after disaster impact (6) Make awareness about the Preparedness to combat with Disaster (6) Identify the High Risk Zones of earth-quake etc. (7) Sensitize the people, how can we rescue and rehabilitate the people during and after the Disaster etc. (8) To give training among the employees, staff, teachers and students about the preparedness to combat Disaster and rescue the people during disaster etc.

The Department of Secondary Education is presently implementing the centrally sponsored schemes of Rashtriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhijan, Saakshar Bharat Mission and on the other hand Department of Elementary Education is implementing the Sarba Siksha Abhijan.

Organizational structure at the State and District level:-

The Govt. in Education Department is headed by Principal Secretary to the Govt. of Assam with head quarter at Dispur, Guwahati and he is assisted by Commissioner & Secretary to the Govt. of Assam Elementary Education Department and Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Secondary Education Department and other officers of the rank of Joint Secretary, Deputy Secretaries etc. There are three Directorate functioning under the Department of Secondary Education namely Directorate of Secondary Education, Directorate of Madrasa Education and Directorate of Non-formal and Adult Education. Similarly under Department of Elementary Education there are two Directorates namely Directorate of Elementary Education and Directorate of SCERT.

At the district level in respect of Director Secondary Education, the Inspector of School is the district level authority and the District Elementary Education officer is the district level authority in respect of elementary schools. Regarding Madrasah system of Education the Director Madrasah Education is the state authority and Superintendent of the Madrasahs (both Pre-Senior and Senior) looks after the respective Madrasahs at the district level. Regarding SCERT the Director is the authority at the state level and he is assisted by officers of the rank

of Joint Director, Deputy Director and the academic side is looked after by the Readers, Lecturers and others.

The Organizational structure of SCERT, Directorate of Secondary Education, Directorate of Elementary Education, Directorate of Non-Formal & Adult Education and Directorate Madrassa Education is shown at **Annexure-I, II, III & IV** .

Data profile about Students enrolment/Schools

In respect of Directorate of SCERT there are 27 nos. of DIETs located in almost all the Districts which are functioning and there are 14 nos. of BIET which are under process of construction.

Chapter. 2.

Hazard & Vulnerability Scenario

2.1. Nature, Frequency and Intensity of Disasters in the State:

Assam has been prone to both natural and man-made disaster since long. Natural Disaster like flood, earthquake and drought are regular features in the state. But cyclone is less frequently observed. Since 1950 Assam has experienced floods every year, droughts occasionally and cyclone almost every year on or before the onset of the month of April. These natural disasters have not only led to loss of human lives but also resulted in damage to property. The value of properties lost and damaged due to natural disasters has also been increasing over the decades. Thus natural calamities have become a problem for the poor people of Assam by increasing their vulnerability and have also caused serious fiscal imbalances by heavy demands on revenue expenditure; expenditure on restoring assets and property loss and the most affected community are the students who come from rural background and more importantly the agricultural class, rural artisans etc.

Disasters are classified into two categories which is natural disaster with widespread dimension and the other one is localized calamities. Both the categories are mentioned below:

2.2. Frequency and intensity of Disasters:

In Assam occurrence of flood by way of over flooding of Brahmaputra River, its tributaries and Barak River is a regular feature and its intensity is very high. Similarly drought is a common feature mostly in the districts of Dibrugarh, Sibsagar, Jorhat, Golaghat, Nagaon, Lakhimpur and Sonitpur. Which is experienced almost every alternate year. The types of disasters, their frequency and intensity are mentioned in the table below:

2.4. Causes of losses / damages:

There is a recognized high degree of interdependency between sustainable development and vulnerability to natural Hazards High vulnerability means higher exposure to natural catastrophes in the absence of disaster risk reduction measures. Vulnerability also depends on aspects such as hazard awareness, the characteristics of human settlement and infrastructure, Public Policy and administration and organised abilities in all fields of disaster management. At present, poverty is one major causes of vulnerability in many parts of the world.

Causes & consequences or loss due to floods in the community is given below:-

Sl. No.	Causes of losses	Consequences / Loss
1	Water logging (During flood)	Contagious disease, outbreak problems in mobility, cut off from mainstream, affects both old & infirm and people with disability, difficulty in getting food stuff, Problem of referrals during extreme medical emergency.
2	Water surge due to flood	Fatalities of new borne babies, cases of drowning particularly children and school going children problems in mobility, cut-off from mainstream, affects old people and people with disability and children, difficulties in getting food stuff, Problem of referrals during extreme medical emergency, fear of snakes etc. flowing in with water, collapse of schools buildings, departmental building, damage to equipments and records, schools furnitures, school laboratories, cases of missing women and school children.
3	Damage of power and electricity	Affect hospitals, Schools, household emergency services, food production units, fear of animals, snakebites etc. electric shocks due to damaged wires and cables.

4	Building Collapse	Injury to people, loss of shelter, safety and security of woman, girls children, old and disabled persons and more particularly Students.
5	Water Scarcity	Cause of epidemics like diarrhoea, Woman and girls have to walk miles to fetch water, stress effect on pregnant woman and school going children.
6	Crop loss in case of drought & flood	Food Scarcity, malnourishment affects the children and also affects the nutrition in pregnant & lactating woman, death due to hunger, trafficking of woman due to poverty etc.

Apart from the public health and nutrition consequences of disasters such as epidemics and the threat to the food supply, disasters also have negative economic consequences. There is a negative impact on the livelihood of the people, thus reducing the livelihood sources in rural areas and leading to school dropout, Loss of income increases poverty levels which gives rise to the following social problems:-

- a. Increase in trafficking of girls and woman
- b. Increase in malnourishment and under nutrition.
- c. Migration and mass exodus in search of income & livelihood.
- d. Physical and mental abuse of woman and School going children.
- e. Reduction in family planning methods
- f. Increase in contagious diseases, skin infections, sexually transmitted infection etc.
- g. Increase in cases of missing children and woman.
- h. Rise in crime rates.

Hazard Mitigation and Vulnerability Reduction Plan:-

Disasters that cannot be prevented are considered for mitigation and vulnerability reduction planning. Long-term activities which aim to reduce the impact of a hazard on vulnerable communities are carried out, including:

- Diversification of incomes/livelihood alternatives.
- Food security.
- Training for community in disaster planning and management.
- Disaster resistant housing programmes.
- Building codes.
- Environmental protection.

2.5. Identification of Hazard prone Educational Institutions/infrastructure in terms of flood, earthquake and landslide etc.:

a. Regarding structural and Non-structural vulnerability to earthquake wind, flood and fire, the Inspector of Schools and District Elementary Education Officers of the Districts in consultation with the Headmaster/Principals of the District schools will prepare an action

calendar and after due discussion with the District Disaster Management Authority headed by DM will survey the vulnerability through technical persons as per indices as indicated below.

- i. Whether the building have a hipped roof ?
- ii. Is the building irregular in plan/grid ?
- iii. Does the building possess eccentric cores ?
- iv. Does the building have short columns ?
- v. Does the building have strong beams but weak columns ?
- vi. Whether the building directions adequately braced or not (i.e RC frames, shear walls, masonry walls) ?
- vii. Does the building has a soft storey ?
- viii. Whether the building possess a heavy mass at the top or at roof level ?
- ix. Whether the building is irregular in elevation caused by set backs of upper stories /cantilever ?

Based on the findings the District School authorities will take steps for rectification. The school authority at the district level will also make a survey of school requiring retrofitting/ restoration and rehabilitation solutions and also the schools which become unapproachable during flood time and schools in which classrooms are inundated. Further, they also have to identify the schools in which courtyard / playground remains water logged for more than one month and require anti water logging measures. Moreover, the schools in landslide prone localities and schools having high tension line passing nearby or above the school campus also have to identified and rectification measures have to be taken with intimation to Director Secondary Education and Director Elementary Education as the case may be.

Chapter 3

Main task of the Department and Possibilities of integration of related Disaster Management aspects in State, District and Local levels.

3.1. Pre-Disaster:

Planning has to be done in a scientific way as per inputs shown below:

- Organizing awareness campaign and promoting community education on disaster preparedness.
- Articulation of community need for developing preparations plan through community involvement and through local Head Master of LP / ME, MV /High School or Higher Secondary Schools.
- Identifying the resource gaps both physical and manpower and replacing the same through capacity building.
- Establishing relationship with local agencies including NGOs etc.
- Establishing relationship with local heads of institutions of educational health, police, fire brigade and District Disaster Management Authority headed by Deputy Commissioner / Addl. Deputy Commissioner.
- Activating the D.M. plans with the participation of community.

- Formation of Response Plan, Trigger Mechanism for response , School Managing Committee , Mock Drill and other activities relating to skill upgradation / capacity building of the stake holders.
 - Liaison with Officer In-charge of District Disaster Management Plan and constitution of incident response team.
 - Maintenance of fire extinguishers. The Directorate of Secondary Education has purchased fire extinguisher and provided to all the Secondary Schools for use at the time of fire hazards in the school.
 - Retrofitting Solutions: The Department has to assess the vulnerability of the buildings and if required retrofitting / repair / rehabilitation steps have to be taken as per budget estimate with available resources/ fund.
 - The Govt. is examining to introduce a chapter about Disaster Management in School Curriculum in Secondary Schools.
 - The Department has to conduct regular mock drills in the Schools at the School Level in consultation with DDMA.
 - The Students and School staff needs to be trained in basic first aid, search and rescue matter in consultation with District Health Authorities and Fire Service Authorities.
 - Rally and Education Programmes has to be organized to raise awareness.
 - The Department Disaster Plan needs to be uploaded in the Department Website.
 - Enforcement of building codes.
 - Dissemination of safety guidelines.
 - Awareness campaign about hazards and their impacts.
 - Structural mitigation measures.
 - Warning systems.
 - Evacuation plans depending on the structure and local environment.
 - Resource inventories.
 - Communities awareness/ Education.
 - Emergency communications.
 - Organize demonstration on fire safety, first aid and charge and rescue operations in consultation with local police authority, Health Department fire brigade and district administration.
 - All schools/ Education Institutions have to constitute different cells for rescue operations namely logistic cell, medical cell, fire safety cell, co-ordination cell, evacuation team etc.
 - All school should have a map showing the exit points and other relative information and should be displayed on the school premises.
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- Prepare a brief inventory of articles that may be needed to launch immediate rescue operation at School level. Such inventory may include small tools that will be used to break open any door, break any wall to rescue trapped students in case of emergency. Further the school authority should keep a record of where from you will collect the tools immediately in case of emergency from households situated near the schools.

- **Maintenance of Inventory of resources in the school-** The list of material resources includes Stretchers, Fire Extinguishers, Ladder, Thick Ropes, Torch, Communication System and First-Aid-Box, List of Human Resource (Teachers and Students having knowledge on First-Aid rescue and evacuation). If possible such type of tools should be purchased from school fund and be kept in the school. Besides sand and water reservoir may be arranged in the school campus within easy reach for use.

Notification of Nodal Officers

- Nodal Officer has been notified in respect of all the Directorates falling under Secondary Education Department where Director shall be the Nodal Officer and in respect of the Districts the Inspector of Schools will be the Nodal Officer pertaining to High Schools/ Higher Secondary Schools and Jr. Colleges. Regarding Directorate of Madrassa Education the District Elementary Education officer will be the Nodal Officer in respect of Pre Senior Madrassa and the Inspector of Schools will be the Nodal Officer in respect of Senior Madrassa/ Title Madrassa and High. A copy of notification is placed at **Annexure-VIII**

Quick response team (QRT)

The quick response team has to be constituted by Inspector of school/ District Elementary Education Officers/ Block Elementary Officers with representatives of different line department for early response to the disaster. The team will be under back and call of the officer incharge of the district disaster management cell and on receipt of information from the Nodal; Officer the head of the cell will mobilize the QRT.

Constitutions of Incident Response Team

IRT may be constituted as part of the District Disaster Management Cell with representation of Police, Revenue Officers, Health officers, Fire brigade authority and other officials of various line departments. The mandate of IRT include evacuation of affected population to safer places, rescue, temporary shelter, medical assistance to the affected persons, supply of food and drinking water, Sanitation and other necessary technical support.

Prevention and Mitigation

It is an important spectrum of Disaster Management planning and has to be done in an effective way as stated below.

Periodical Inspection of the Building:

Injuries/ Casualties at the time of earthquakes occur due to collapse of wall/roof/columns of buildings. Therefore inspection of the building of the school is highly essential periodically. Accordingly the Heads of the School shall identify cracks on the walls, Inspect the Ceiling/roof. If any crack is noticed, they shall go for immediate repair in consultation with District authority.

Inspection of Electric Connection:

Make sure that there is facility to disconnect electricity in the School if situation calls for. The main switch should be located within easy reach of the School authority and the teachers and ensure that it is in working condition. **Prominently display a signboard mentioning “Main Switch” and pull the red handle down “near the main switch”.** It may be noted that in major disasters like fires, the owners or residents of the building were unaware of the location of the main switch.

Exit Routes

The School authority shall ensure that the doors of Class Rooms are wide enough to facilitate evacuation of students. The doors should not have hindrances of any kind. As far as practicable ensure that there are two gates in each Class Room and while constructing new rooms this should be kept in mind.

Evacuation team should be formed in each school engaging Civil Defense, Red Cross Society, NGOs, NCC, NSS, Scout and Guide etc. The team will make a plan for evacuation of School Building for safety of the students and others. Evacuation Route Map should be displayed in the school premises showing the exit route by arrows in the map, also alternative exit route, in case the main route is damaged and not accessible.

Identify Safer Places

For taking shelter after the disaster, School Authority shall identify safe place for students and others members.

Fire Fighting Equipments :

Make available at least 3 buckets full of soil that can be used in case of fire. In the meant time the Directorate shall take steps to provide Fire Extinguishers to all educational institutions.

First Aid Box:

Keep a First Aid Box in the School campus and also Keep an old used Rug (Kambol) and learn how it can be used as stretcher to carry injured during an emergency. Mock drilling exercise is highly essential.

Important Telephone Numbers :

The telephone numbers of the following important functionaries as shown below has to be maintained :-

1. Officer in charge of local police station.
2. Revenue Circle officer
3. Block Development officer
4. Nearest Fire Station Officer.
5. Ambulance Service
6. Telephone numbers of doctors / hospitals
7. Contact Numbers of Village Sarpanch/ Gaon Burha

Formation of School wise Disaster Management Committee

The committee shall consist of the following :-

1. School Head Master / Principal - Chairman
2. Vice Principal / Asstt. Head Master- Member Secretary.
3. President / Secretary of School Management Committee- Member.
4. Local concerned Education officer of the area – Member
5. Local Member of Municipal Administration / Gaon Panchayat- Member
6. Local Guardians – (2 nos.)- Member.
7. Doctor in charge of nearest health centre-Member
8. Officer in charge of nearest Fire Station- Member
9. Local NGO/ Volunteer Organization- Member.
10. Bharat Scout and Guide/ NCC- Member

Structural Safety Requirement of the Buildings

The age of the Educational Institution ranges from more than 100 years to recent time. Hence there is the necessity to observe the construction practices of different times and to assess their vulnerability. Most likely in existing vulnerable buildings, structural collapse poses the greatest threat to life in a major earthquake. Now, choosing the method of protection from structural collapse in a deficient building requires critical decisions regarding replacement or restore / retrofit / rehabilitate. The District Education Authority in consultation with Deputy Commissioner of the districts will identify the vulnerable buildings with the help of Department of P.W.D. (Building) . Regarding non structural safety element such as laboratory equipment / installation or furniture may not influence the building stability but it may put the students and the contents of the building at risk and increases the follow up losses during evacuation. Hence non structural safety & vulnerability should also be adhered and treated separately.

Response and SOP:

3.2. During Disaster

- Arranging emergency communication through available resources
- Evacuation to temporary shelter and running relief camps.
- Supplementing rescue and relief effects in Co-ordinating different agencies.
- Monitoring of Relief distribution
- Safe disposal of carcass and arranging safe drinking water and Imitation.
- Don't panic and not allow your students to get panicky.
- Ensure there is no panicky situation.
- Don't allow students to run, it may cause stampede at the doors.
- If situation allows get the students out one by one in the open.
- The teacher in the class room should ask the students to come under the cover of desk-bench and firmly hold the legs of such tables and benches till the tremors comes to halt.
- Take cover under tables, desks and hold at first sign of earthquake. Hold on to furniture legs if furniture moves. If outside, move away from buildings, electric wires.
- In case of other hazards, assist the **Evacuation Team** in evacuation of the school building.

What to do during an Earthquake

Stay as safe as possible during an earthquake. Be aware that some earthquakes are actually foreshocks and a larger earthquake might occur. Minimize your movements to a few steps that reach a nearly safe place and stay indoors until the shaking has stopped and you are sure exiting is safe.

If indoors

- DROP to the ground; take COVER by getting under a sturdy table or other piece of furniture; and HOLD ON until the shaking stops. If there is no a table or desk near you, cover your face and head with your arms and crouch in an inside corner of the building.
- Protect yourself by staying under the lintel of an inner door, in the corner of a room, under a table.
- Stay away from glass, windows, outside doors and walls, and anything that could fall, (such as lighting fixtures or furniture).
- Use a doorway for shelter only if it is in close proximity to you and if you know it is a strongly supported, load bearing doorway.
- Stay inside until the shaking stops and it is safe to go outside. Research has shown that most injuries occur when people inside buildings attempt to move to a different location inside the building or try to leave.
- Be aware that the electricity may go out or the sprinkler systems or fire alarms may turn on.

If trapped under debris

- Do not light a match.
- Do not move about or kick up dust.
- Cover your mouth with a handkerchief or clothing.
- Tap on a pipe or wall so rescuers can locate you. Use a whistle if one is available. Shout only as a last resort. Shouting can cause you to inhale dangerous amounts of dust.

Relief and Rehabilitation

3.3. Post Disaster

- Damage assessment particularly assisting in identifying victims for compensation and its distribution.
- Formulating rehabilitation and reconstruction plan of houses and other local infrastructures.
- Safe reconstruction.
- Supervision and monitor long term reconstruction and mitigation Projects.
- Mobilizing special funds to use disaster resistant construction technology in vulnerable areas.
- Carcass disposal, disinfectant spray and immunization
- Consolation to the victims

- Damage assessment and relief distribution
- Reconstruction, Resettlement, Rehabilitation, Recovery, Redevelopment.

Rehabilitation Plan:

This is the phase in which the community is back on the trails. As they are fine tuning their resources to deal with other emergencies, they are in a position to provide help to some other disaster affected areas. Rehabilitation includes:

- Shelter Rehabilitation
- Livelihood Rehabilitation
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation

Disaster Recovery Plan:

Recovery is the restoration of the community structure and facilities. Support provided to affected people, including providing short-term emergency accommodation, counseling emotionally-affected people, establishing and managing emergency financial relief schemes, repairing damaged public utilities, services and assets and surveying and assessing damage to public and private property. Rapid steps must be taken to establish a system of continuous contact with the families stricken by the disaster.

3.4. Capacity Building at all level in vulnerable areas flood / cyclone / Earthquake.

State Level :

One day training Programme cum awareness programme may be organized at state level i.e. in the Directorate of SCERT, Assam, Kahilipara, Guwahati involving officials of Directorate of Secondary Education, Directorate of Madrassa Education, Directorate of Elementary, Directorate of Non-Formal & Adult Education for better supervision, monitoring and taking preventive measures.

District Level:

All the Principals of DIETs, BTCs, Normal Schools, HTTCs, CTEs, Higher Secondary Schools, High schools and Jr. colleges alongwith staff members may be trained to effectively manage flood /Earthquake and cyclone etc. Principal of DIET and District disaster management cell with organize the workshop. Depending upon the members of the participants the training batch will be decided. At least a batch size of a programme should have not more than 50 participants.

Community Level:

On a particular day a public awareness programme may be organized in each village to sensitize the community. All the youths of locality led by the local teacher (LP / ME /MV/High/Higher Secondary School) will be trained. More over members of local development committee, Mothers committee, Village volunteers will be trained regarding disaster preparedness, relief, rescue, provisioning of services, management of the different categories

of beneficiaries etc. Technical personal from District /Sub Division /Block will co-ordinate this programme with the help of village contact person. In this public awareness Programme at the village, relevant posters, leaflets, pamphlets in simple local language will be distributed to all the participants.

3.5. Public awareness through I.T. and I.E.C. activities :

Mass awareness programme may be conducted through different audio-visual media to sensitize the community as well as the functionaries.

The D.M. plan with responsibilities and check lists to be displayed in all LP/ ME/MV/High Schools /Higher Secondary Schools and also to all community persons.

3.6. Prepositioning of supplies and demarcation of areas and spaces where temporary services can be provided:

- Disaster preparedness shall include prepositioning of food stocks including Take Home Ration (THR), emergency medicine, sanitary napkins, safe delivery kits, family planning kits etc. for sufficient number of days.
- Also spaces /areas shall be pre-demarcated to provide services for new born care, emergency deliveries, safety & security of woman & girls, conducive space for old and infirm.
- Each category of personnel shall be made aware of their responsibilities to avoid any kind of confusion during disaster management.

3.7. Fund requirement for Prevention of disaster, mitigation capacity Building and preparedness

- Department will make adequate budget provision in their annual departmental budget for the purpose of disaster management on the basis of proposal received from the Directorates and consultation with Finance Department, Revenue and DM Department.

Buildings needs to be checked for resilience and safety

- The department would ensure that all it's building to be constructed use resilient design and material. The building and space being currently used as educational institute must be checked for its resilience and safely regularly.
- Department will promote that members of community and volunteers assist during emergency.
- Steps will be taken for preparation of information templates and monitoring check lists for monitoring and reporting.

Chapter 4:

4.1 Response plan procedure for relief:

All those action taken immediately following a disaster where exceptional measures are required to meet the basic needs of survivors are called Disaster response. These are the measures undertaken to ensure survival and prevent further deterioration of the situation. These include search cum Rescue, immediate repair and restoration of critical facility and utility. The provision of assistance or intervention during or immediately after a disaster to meet the life preservation and basic subsistence needs of those people affected. It can be of an immediate, short term or protected duration.

A trained and equipped team is highly essential and should be made available within the affected area to deal with disaster preparedness and response in a more organized and systematic manner so that loss of lives and Properties can be minimized.

Disaster Response and Monitoring

4.2: Role and Responsibilities:

- State Level: Directors of Secondary Education/Elementary education/ Madrassa Education/ SCERT/Non-Formal & Adult Education will co-ordinate with the Government in Education Department, related line department, media and District Nodal Officers. Monitoring is highly essential.
- District level : Principal DIET/CTE/High Schools/ Higher Secondary Schools/ Jr. Colleges/ Elementary & Secondary Schools will co-ordinate with DC, Nodal officer, local NGO and Media, and also will act as mediator in between the Department and District & Block level functionaries.
- Block Level : Head Master of High /Higher Secondary School will act as mediator/Co-ordinator with district Authority and villages level authority.
- Village Level : HM of LP/ME/MV school or any local youth organization may act as a coordinator to communicate the emergency messages to community persons and block and District level authorities.

Chapter 5:

5.1 Standard operating procedure:

The Disaster Management Committees at different levels will be kept ready so that they can move to disaster site / affected area on short notice. The standard operating procedure shall be followed as shown below:-

5.2. Primary Task (Before the disaster):

- To co-ordinate with Govt. of Assam and SDMA, Assam
- To co-ordinate the Relief Recovery operation in the wake of disasters.
- To declare and notify Disaster situation.
- Sensitization of officials on Disaster Management Plan Awareness of stakeholders for adherence of stipulated requirements under different Acts Dissemination of information for prevention & mitigation of disaster through brochure & leaflets.

5.3. Preparedness Functions:

- Maintenance of infrastructure at the district level in working order and all inventories updated
- Train-up the personnel on operations
- Ensure basic facilities for personal who will work at district level for disaster response.
- To co-ordinate the preparedness functions of all line departments.
- Establish disaster management funding mechanisms to ensure adequate resources for preparedness work, and quick availability of resources for relief and rehabilitation when required.
- Establish and activate help lines through police and district public relations office.
- Prepare a list of potential shelters with clearly specifying their capacity and check upon their suitability for accommodating people with varying social environment and behavior.
- Prepare a plan for the disposal of dead bodies and car-casses.

During Disaster (SOP)

- Intimation to District Level Disaster Management Cell
- Mobilization of Quick Response Team (QRT) and Incident Response Team (IRT)
- Triggering warning in the affected area.

After Disaster

- Assessment of loss through a team of Officers
- Financial assistance through Financial Institutions for reconstruction
- Monitoring & follow up for rehabilitation
- Documentation of lessons learnt & dissemination of experience with State Level Disaster Management Cell.

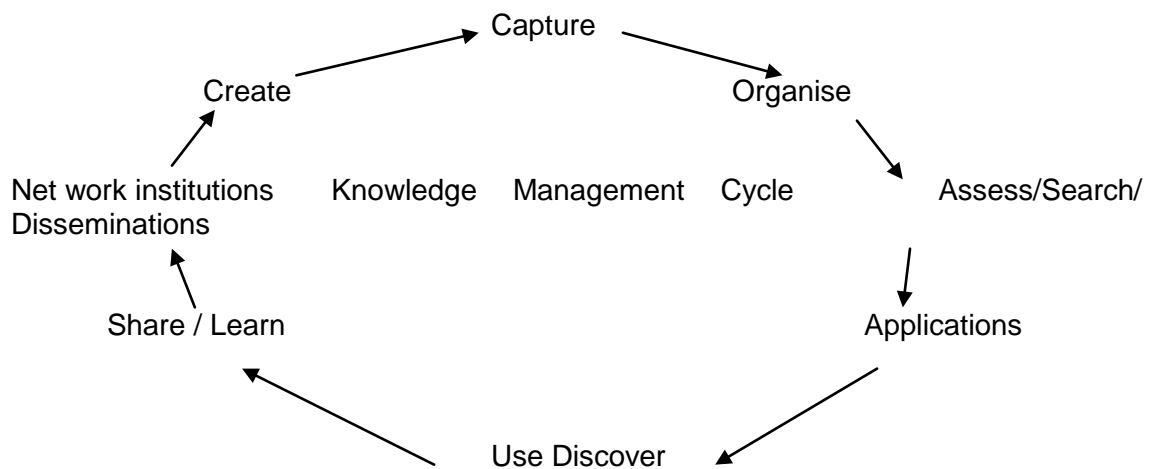
5.4. Mitigation:

- Ensure that funds are being allocated for disaster Management
- Ensure that structural and non-structural mitigation measures are taken at Block and District level.
- Establish warning system between state – District and in high risk zone/ Schools.
- Monitor implementation of construction norms for all types of building and infrastructure.
- Advise concerned DDMA to carry out evacuation where required and to keep transport relief and medical teams ready to move to the affected areas at a short notice.
- Provide assessment report to the Director SCERT/Director Secondary Education/Madrassa Education/Non-Formal & Adult Education/ Elementary Education, Assam as and when required.

5.5. Response:

- Coordinate and plan all activities with SDMA.
- Conduct Rapid Assessment and launch Quick Response information on hazards, vulnerabilities and capacities. In a broader context, information about disaster preparedness, dos' and don'ts in emergency, disaster management plans, policies and guidelines are available at various domains from decades. However, millions of

people are getting severely affected by disasters every year due to lack of adequate coping mechanisms. This may be attributed to the fact that the information lying at one place is not getting transformed into the lifesaving knowledge for the communities at risk. The Department may follow the below mentioned approach for knowledge management



- The network of knowledge institutions bridges the gap between information coordination and sharing and brings together knowledge and experiences of disaster practitioners capture, organize.
- Conduct survey in affected areas and assess requirement of relief.
- Distribute emergency relief material to affected population.
- Ensure the supply of food grains through the public Distribution System.
- Prepare a list of relief items to be distributed.

5.6. Recovery and Rehabilitation:

- Ensure preparation of rehabilitation plan for displaced population.
- Organise initial and subsequent technical assessment of disaster affected areas and determine the extent of loss and damage and volume and nature of relief required.
- Keep ASDMA/Education Department informed of the situation.
- Ensure supply of food, medical supplies and other emergency items to the affected population.
- Coordinate the activities of NGOs in relief and rehabilitation programmes.
- Ensure Rehabilitation Plan which includes Shelter rehabilitation, Livelihood rehabilitation, Psychosocial rehabilitation.

Chapter 6:

Knowledge Management

Disaster Management requires the collection compilation and dissemination of relevant knowledge and share this knowledge and to create a versatile interface among policy makers in the Government and disaster managers at all administrative level.

Further knowledge institutions for disaster management shall document the best practices and upload the same in the website of the department.

Chapter 7:

Review, upgradation, dissemination of DM Plan

The Disaster Management plan for Secondary Education will be a living document. Regular improvement & up-dating of the plan will be required at least once a year. Disaster Management Plan will be subject to review each year by the Department with suggestions from Revenue & Disaster Management Department, Govt. of Assam.

Plan updation:

The Nodal Officer of State Level DM Cell/Directorate/District Level shall update all data in the Departmental website regularly. The District Level DM Cell will also update its database and action plans for disaster management in consultation with the district level officers. The DSE Department will ensure updation of DMP from time to time through a designated officer.

On occurrence of Fire

Smoke gives first warning of an imminent fire. When smoke is seen, or smell of smoke or burning is sensed, the teacher will immediately go to the place from where such smoke is emanating. If it is in some electrical wiring he/she will immediately switch off the switches and shall not allow students to go near such smoke. He/She will ask for the Fire extinguisher, apply it and try to extinguish the fire with sand. Evacuate the students in open space.

Immediate Response by School Staffs / Teachers and Students :-

If anyone is caught in fire immediately STOP, DROP & ROLL. The members of designated team need to be activated in order to take up their designated post/ positions to accomplish their tasks effectively and the rest of the members should act in accordance in their roles.

Response Phase by Designated Teams:-

The designated Evacuation Team evacuates the whole school building through pre-determined safe exit routes into the designated assembly point. The Fire Fighting Team will take position and douse off the fire (created scenario) with fire fighting equipments. The search and Rescue Team will thoroughly check the whole building one on one basis and rescue and carry the injured (if any role play) to the designated First Aid Post. The First – Aid Team will provide the basis First – Aid and will further refer the injured to the nearest medical centre. The Transport Management Team will ensure that the referral victim is carried to the already identified medical centre. The Site Safety Team will cordon off the whole building area restricting traffic flow inside the school premises and ensures the safety of the gathering.

On occurrence of Floods

Monitor the water level of the river if the school is situated nearby a river or near an embankment. If due to heavy rains, if any portion of the embankment near the school is seen threatened, it is better to send students home instead of taking any risk. Identify in advance a high raised place where the students can be sheltered if water enters suddenly. Wait for help from agencies to arrive.

Capacity Building of Departmental functionaries and Citizen engagement

The Departmental functionaries of Education Department right from top to bottom involving all stake holders have to be trained on planning and effective management of Disaster Management from time to time through field mock and drill exercise at the State level/District level /Block level and school level in consultation with ASDMA and DDMA. In this connection the State and local NGOs, voluntary organizations, leading citizens, NCC cadres/ Scouts & Guides personnel, SDRF personnel have to be associated with the programme.

Dissemination of the Plan to everybody in the School:-

The School Disaster Management Committee shall discuss the plan with every member of the School and hold periodical meetings. The School shall organize mock drills at least twice a year. Holding of mock drill is the base on which success rate of the plan depends. Hence, discuss the plan at regular intervals and hold mock drill regularly.

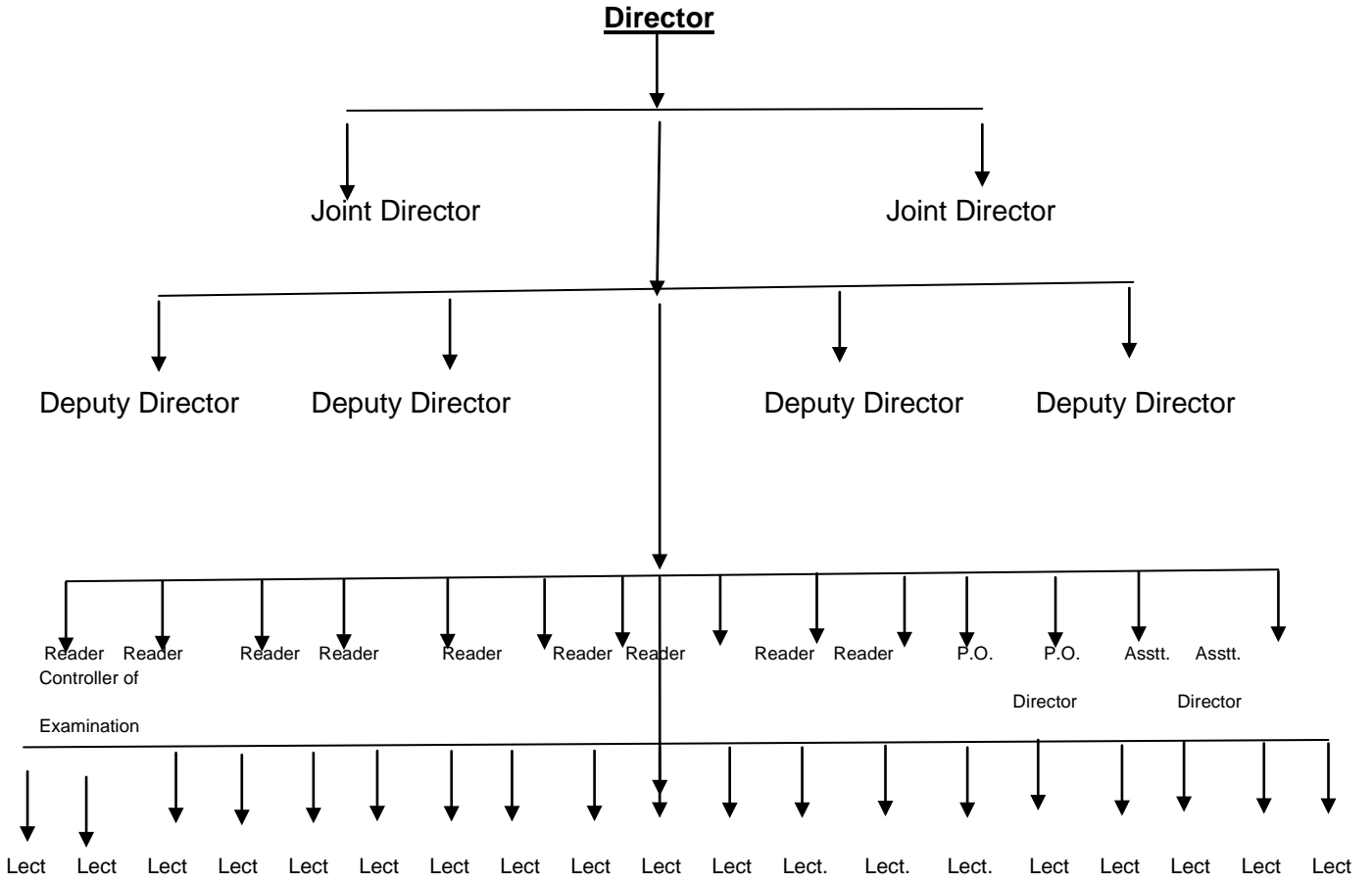

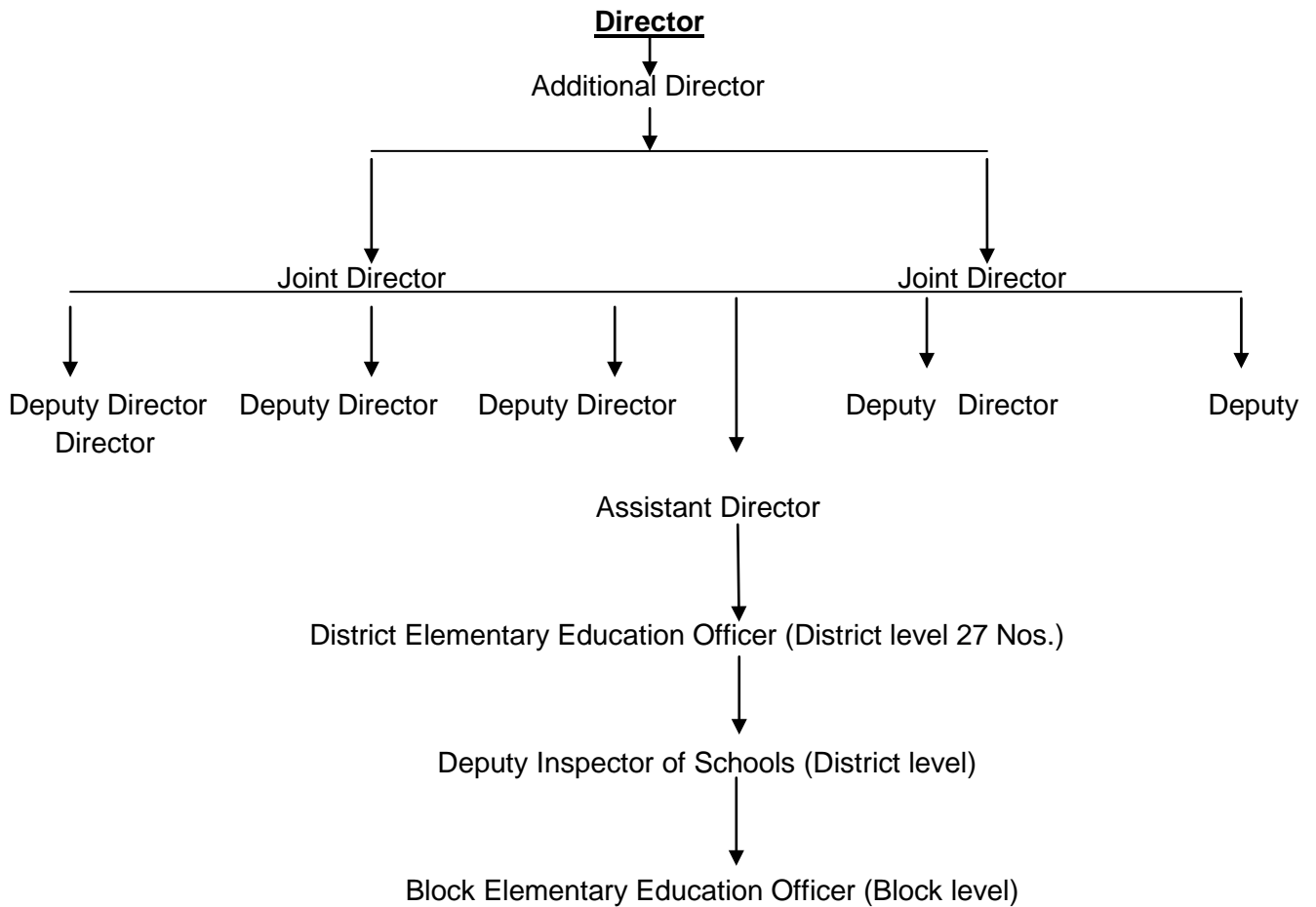
Directorate of SCERT

(Organizational Structure)

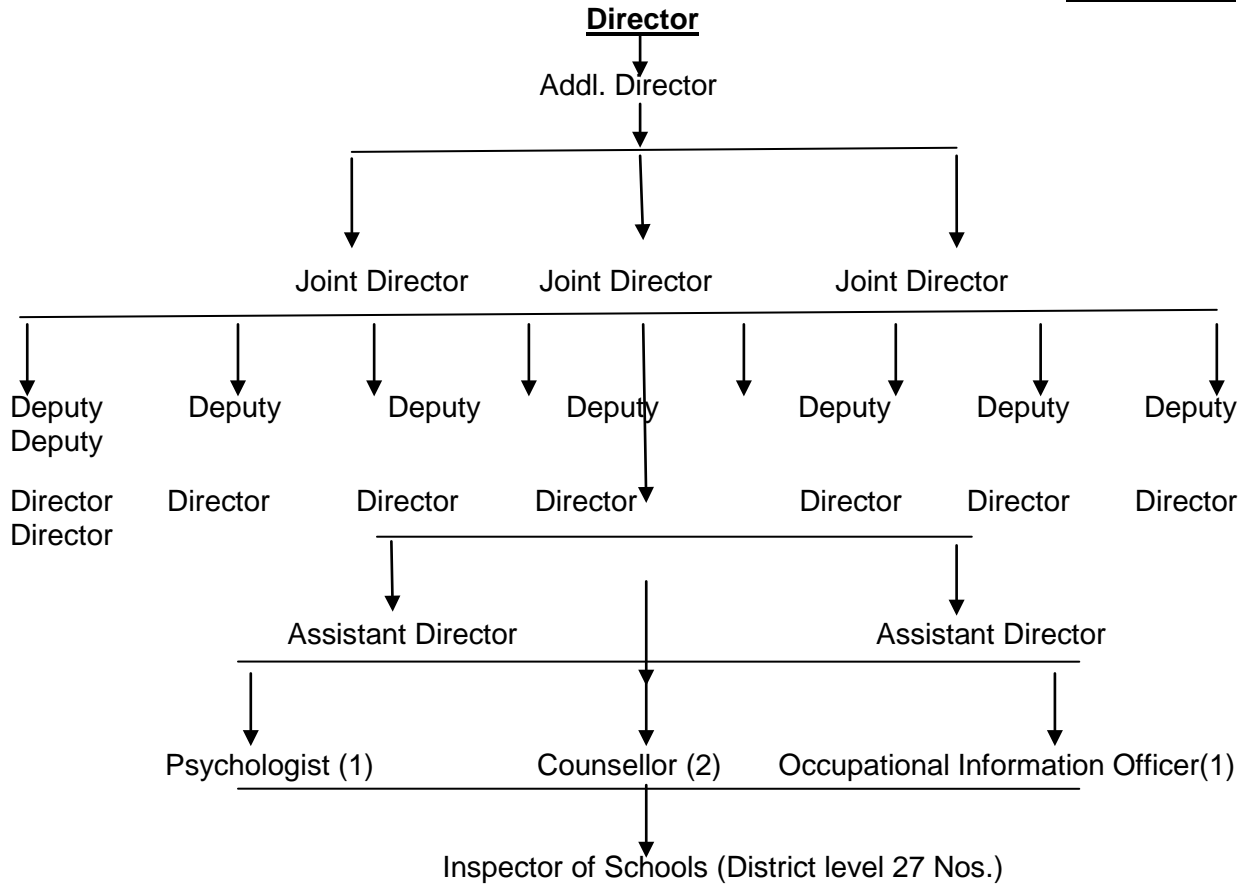

(Organizational Structure)

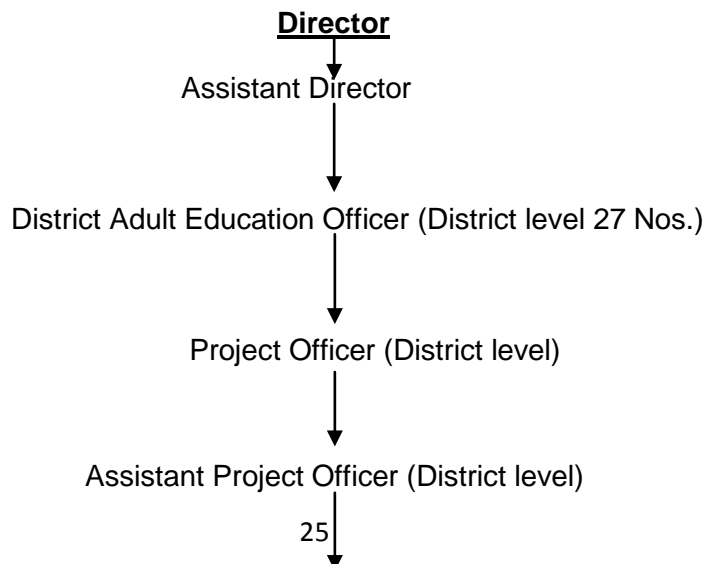

2. The Inspector of Schools at the District Level shall be the Nodal officer of their respective Districts pertaining to High Schools/ Higher Secondary Schools / Junior Colleges and he/she shall maintain close liaison with the Deputy Commissioner of the District /District Disaster Management Authority/Director of Secondary Education/Head Master / Principal of respective Schools/ Junior Colleges/ School Managing Committee.

b. Directorate of Madrassa Education, Assam

1. In respect of Directorate of Madrassa Education, the Director shall be the Nodal Officer of Disaster Management and he/ she will maintain close liaison with the Govt in Secondary Education Department, Assam State Disaster Management Authority and the District Nodal Officers.
2. The District Elementary Education Officer will be the Nodal Officer in respect of Pre Senior Madrassas and the Inspector of Schools will be the Nodal Officer in respect of Senior Madrassal /Title Madrassas and High Madrassas. They will maintain close liaison with Director of Madrassa Education/ Deputy Commissioner of the District and District Disaster Management Authority.
